- Members are actively encouraged to wear club kit at races and events.
- Members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the club secretary or any other member of the committee; details on how to do this are outlined in the grievance procedure.

As a member of LFR you agree to abide by the following:

1. To comply with the appropriate EA code of conduct relevant to your role (Athlete, Coach, Official, volunteer etc). These codes of conduct are available on the LFR website.
2. To comply with all club policies and procedures, which are available on the website.
3. Not to bring the club (LFR) into disrepute.
4. To pay any fees for membership, training , club kit or events promptly.

## **Breach of the code of Conduct**

The committee shall have power by ordinary resolution to take the following actions against any member who fails to adhere to the Membership Code of Conduct:

- Ask the member to apologise for behaviour
- Receive a verbal or written warning from the committee
- Be suspended from attending club sessions
- Be suspended from the club
- Be required to leave the club
